

## Importing the Academic Integrity Blackboard Module into Your Course

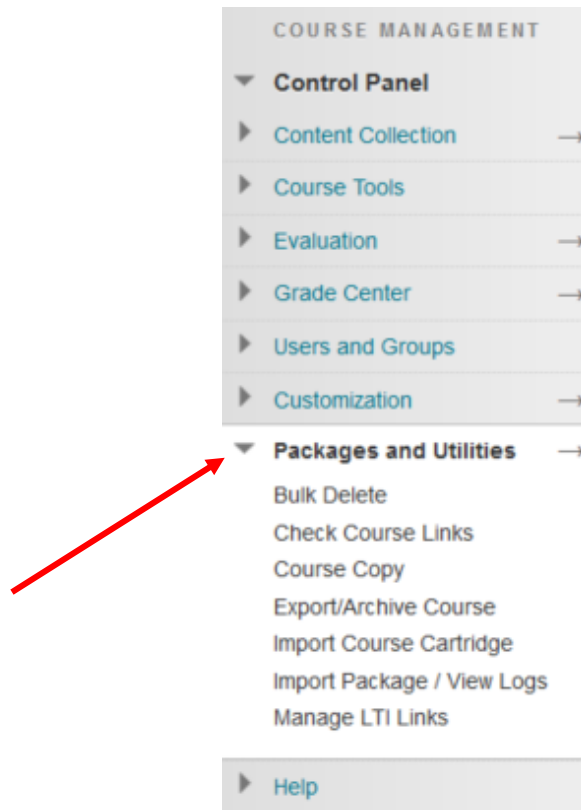
This module, once imported, is automatically setup to be unavailable to the students in the course. This includes the Plagiarism Test and the printable version of the test. The Grade Center column associated with the Plagiarism Test is hidden from the students as well.

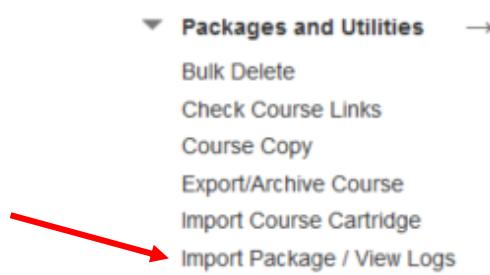
1. Download the Academic Integrity Module ZIP file and save to a location on your local computer.

**Note:** If you have a Mac, please go to **Properties** and uncheck **Open Safe Files After Downloading...** so that the ZIP file does not automatically Extract the files.


2. Log into Blackboard and enter the course where you need this module imported.
3. On the lower left sidebar, click on **Packages and Utilities**.



4. Click on **Import Package / View Logs**.



5. Click on the **Import Package** button.

### Import Package

An Import package is a .ZIP file of exported Course content. Importing a package into an existing Course copies the content of the package into the existing Course. Import packages do not include user enrollments or records, such as discussion board posts and assessment attempts. [More Help](#)
